The gambling facility's owner, UTGR, Inc., began making its case Tuesday.

It released an economic impact study it paid for that says allowing <u>Twin River</u> to offer table games could create as many as 650 jobs and create up to <u>\$60 million</u> in revenue for the state and town.

<u>Chafee</u> told <u>WPRO-AM</u> he doesn't see that table games would be a major change from video. He says the Narragansett Indian tribe should share in any expansion.

The General AssemblyIast year passed legislation authorizing a voter referendum on casino
gambling. FormerGov.Don Carcieri vetoed it.
