The 11 defendants indicted in the Alabama gambling probe have all submitted their pleas to the federal charges. All of the 11 defendants who have been accused of accepting bribes over the gambling bill have plead guilty.

Three lobbyists, two casino owners, four state senators, an attorney, and a spokesman for a casino owner were all indicted.

The probe came about when the possibility of corruption was considered in Alabama's legislature. All throughout 2010, the gambling industry in Alabama has been in a tumult. Governor Riley's Task Force on Illegal Gambling had been running rampant through the state, shutting down the different bingo halls in the state.

Riley's assertion is that the bingo machines are actually Vegas style slot games. These slot games are illegal in Alabama. A bill had passed the state Senate earlier this year, but the House

A 12th defendant, according to federal authorities, had plead guilty to conspiracy.
